

ANNOUNCING SOAR SCHOLARSHIP

The Society of Ontario Adjudicators and Regulators is pleased to announce the launching of an annual academic scholarship.

SOAR is an independent, non-profit, non-partisan association of Chairs, members, management and staff of the province's administrative boards, agencies and tribunals. SOAR's mission is to advance administrative justice through education, advocacy and innovation.

To promote interest in and recognize dedication to the principles of administrative law, SOAR will award one \$3,000 scholarship to an upper level (L2 or L3) student enrolled in an Ontario law school who demonstrates a commitment to the administrative justice system. Students must show, in a written essay, how their studies have led them (or will lead them) to embrace the practice of administrative law.

Applications will be accepted no later than July 31 of each calendar year. The award will be presented at SOAR's annual general meeting (December).

SOAR SCHOLARSHIP

The SOAR Scholarship is awarded to upper-level (L2 or L3) students enrolled in an Ontario law school to recognize their academic achievement in Administrative Law and their professed commitment to the administrative justice system through the articulation of past experience or anticipated participation. The Scholarship is in the amount of \$3,000 and will be awarded at SOAR's annual general meeting (December).

The Scholarship criteria include:

- 1. Academic achievement in an Ontario law school: transcript showing marks achieved in L2 or L3 administrative law course(s)
- 2. Curriculum vitae
- 3. Essay of maximum 400 words describing how the candidate has or will contribute to the administrative justice community.

Competed applications must include all three criteria listed above.
