# Understanding

- Have I explained the process and how I will be making decisions?
- Am I using plain language as opposed to legalese and acronyms?
- What are the literacy levels of the parties?
- What language(s) do the parties speak? Do the parties require an interpreter?
- Am I speaking slowly and in short sentences?
- Have I checked in to ensure understanding?
