# 2017 ACTION PLAN

Phase 2 - A brief survey of the registrars and associate chairs of the SJTO member tribunals; and

Phase 3 - A dialogue with Indigenous organizations, leadership and individuals

#### Phase 1

Task

 Initial review focused on terminology used in decisions of SJTO tribunals to refer to Indigenous parties

Outcome

 Delivery of training module for CFSRB-CRB members (Blanket Exercise and Prof Development session) in May 2017

- Conduct interviews with SJTO Associate Chairs and Registrars
- Outcome
- Interviews completed May 2017

### IMPLEMENTATION cont'd

- Phase 3
- Task
- Conduct information sharing and gathering sessions with Indigenous stakeholders

Outcomes

- Sessions completed in Sioux Lookout, Sudbury, Wikwemikong, Thunder Bay
- Delivery of SJTO Information Presentation to NAN CLWs in May 2017

### NEXT STEPS

- Continue dialogue with LAO, OFIFC and law schools
- Continue to develop contacts for external dialogue with Indigenous stakeholders
- Continue to develop training modules and resources for SJTO members and staff as well as external stakeholders
